#### STATE PARKS REMINDS VETERANS OF LIFETIME PASS

The State Parks Division reminds New Mexico resident veterans to apply for their lifetime veterans Pass. With the signing of House Bill 161, which went into effect on July 1, the State Parks Division partnered with the New Mexico Department of Veterans Services to implement this new benefit for New Mexico veterans. The new lifetime pass gives veterans with verified New Mexico residency free access to state parks, including unlimited day use and camping in areas managed by the State Parks Division of the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, according to a news release. In addition, on Veterans Day, any New Mexico resident on active duty, along with their spouse and dependent children, has free access to any state park, the release stated. All day-use and camping fees are waived for active-duty service members and their families on that day. If you are a veteran and have not yet applied for your lifetime pass, contact NMDVS by email at vet.benefits@dvs.nm.gov or by calling 866-433-8387. For more information about the 35 state parks, log on to the website at emnrd.nm.gov/spd or call 888-NMPARKS (1-888-667-2757).


